

BRIGHT HILL LITERARY CENTER WINTER/SPRING WORKSHOPS FOR KIDS & TEENS 2019 & BRIGHT KIDS BOOK CLUB

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Bright Hill's 26th Annual Winter/Spring Literary Workshops for Kids (**We believe in STEAM!**) & Bright Kids Book Club will take place in February and April. Space is limited, so early registration is advised (**registration deadline for both workshops is February 1; Book Club registration is ongoing**).

Note: All Bright Hill Literary Workshops for Kids include writing and visual arts. Children ages 6-14 are eligible. Workshops are led by Bertha Rogers, Master Teaching Artist (& Founding Dir., BHLC). Bright Kids Book Club takes place at different times during the year and is led by Lorinda Morgan and Jennifer Potrzeba. Pre-Registration is required for all workshops.

1. WINTER 2019 - Feb. 18 - 22 – WINTER BREAK - “ICEBERGS: HOW THEY’RE MADE, HOW THEY CALVE, HOW THEY FLIP”

(Taught by Bertha Rogers) - Grades 1-7, Ages 6 - 14: 9 am - 2:30 pm, 5 days – An iceberg or ice mountain is a large piece of freshwater ice that has broken off a glacier or an ice shelf and is floating freely in open water. We will learn how icebergs are formed and where they live and die, then write poetry and prose in the style of the ancient Icelandic eddas, then create sculptures of them and the oceans where they live. On the last day we will present our projects to parents and friends. The cost is \$120., which includes morning & afternoon snacks (students bring their own lunch). Registration is limited to 22 students. (Delaware Academy students, full scholarships; full and partial scholarships for Delaware and Otsego County students).

Note: As you know, space is limited in our workshops, so it is important to register your child as soon as possible.

2. SPRING 2019 - April 15 - 19 - SPRING BREAK - “CAVE ART: WHO MADE IT AND WHY” (Taught by Bertha Rogers) - Grades 1-7, Ages 6-24, 9 am - 2:30 pm, 5 days - Cave paintings are also known as parietal art. They are painted drawings on cave walls or ceilings, mainly of prehistoric origin, dated to some 40,000 years ago in Eurasia. We will study ancient cave art from Indonesia (the oldest) to Europe. Then we will make our own miniature caves with art inside, and create pictograph poems and stories. On the last day we will present our projects to parents and friends. The cost is \$120, which includes morning & afternoon snacks (students bring their own lunch). Registration is limited to 22 students. (Delaware Academy students, full scholarships; full and partial scholarships for Delaware and Otsego County students).

3. BRIGHT KIDS BOOK CLUB

Grades 3 - 8 (Ages 8 - 14) - Fall 2018 - Spring 2019. DATES TBA, weather permitting. Call 607-829-5055 for details. Bright Kids Book Club is led by Lorinda Morgan and Jennifer Potrzeba. Participants vote on books to read and discuss; each student gets a free copy of the book. This fall, the first book read was “The Book Thief.” The second book, being read now, is “Flight 116 Is Down.” This is a FREE PROGRAM of Bright Hill Press & Literary Center, but students must sign up in advance and must come to at least 2 of the 3 sessions for each book.
