***SUMMER 1 - 2019 - JUNE 27-28, JULY- 1-3 - 9 AM - 2:30 PM - "FLYING FRACTALS & WILD WORDS"** - Ages 6 - 14. Five days, June 27 - 28 & July 1-3. (Includes a bus trip to the NY State Museum, Albany, on the second day - 2 hrs each way on school bus). A fractal is a natural phenomenon or a mathematical set that shows a repeating pattern that displays at every scale. We will learn about fractals in nature, then create our own and write fractal poems and stories. We will make dioramas, drawings, and prints, and write about how nature repeats itself. We will also make tunnel books and pop-ups of their characters. On the last day we will present our projects to parents and friends. Cost: \$120, which includes morning and afternoon snacks (students bring bag lunch). (Delaware Academy & CSD students, full scholarships; full and partial scholarships for Delaware and Otsego County students).

Includes a bus trip to the Thomas Cole House, Catskill, NY, on the second day- 2 .15 hrs each way on school bus). We will study trees and why people love them, we will learn how they communicate with each other, and we will learn how to paint in the style of the Hudson River artists, then write stories and poems about trees that we incorporate into artist books. On the last day we will present our projects to parents and friends. Cost: \$120, which includes morning and afternoon snacks (students bring bag lunch). We will visit, learn about the outdoor sculptures and earth works, then create our own miniature worlds with art an write poems and stories about them. On the last day we will present our projects to parents and friends. Cost: \$120, which includes morning and afternoon snacks (students bring bag lunch).
