## ABOUT ALL 3 SUMMER WORKSHOPS

- The Workshops take place at Bright Hill Literary Center's Education Wing, 94 Church Street, Treadwell, NY. Space is limited, so early registration is advised (summer registration begins April 1 with a final deadline May 1; registration forms will be available on BHLC's website by March 5). **All Bright Hill Literary Workshops for Kids** include writing and visual arts and incorporate science and math for projects; we believe in **STEAM. THE WORKSHOPS** take place from 9 am - 2:30 pm; Bright Hill will provide morning and afternoon snacks, but kids should bring their own bag lunches. **CHILDREN ages 6 - 14** (first grade through 7th grade) are welcome. The workshops are designed and led by Bertha Rogers, master teaching artist and founding director of Bright Hill. The fee for each five-day workshop is valued at \$250, but Bright Hill charges only \$160, & full and partial scholarships are available to permanent residents of Delaware and Otsego Counties (Delaware Academy /Delhi Central School students receive full scholarships, provided by the Abraham Kellogg Educational Fund). Registration is limited to 22 students.

### 1. THE TREES ARE CLIMBING TO THE CLOUDS - June 29 - July 3 -

**We** will study trees, how they grow, where they grow, how long they live, and how they communicate with each other, help each other, and why they climb to the clouds. **We will take a day bus trip to the Albany Pine Bush Preserve & Discovery Area.** At Bright Hill Center, we will study and draw trees and clouds and make artist books and trees. We will also write story- and riddle-poems about them. On the last day of the workshop, we will present an exhibit and program for parents and friends.

### 2. WHO WAS HERE BEFORE -

**July 27 - 31 - Includes a trip to the Susquehanna River Archeological Center in Waverly, NY,** a site with native artifacts dating thousands of years ago. We will learn about the Iroquois and pre-Iroquois peoples who settled and lived here, then write about them and make our own artifacts, fossils, and other objects from digs. On the last day of the workshop, we will present an exhibit and program for parents and friends.

### 3. LEGENDS OF THE STARS AND PLANETS - August 10 - 14.

We will study and learn about the stars and planets in our universe, including the related legends from Mayan, Aztec, Roman, Norse, Asian, Middle Eastern, and other cultures. **Activities include a day trip to visit the A. J. Read Science Discovery Center and SUNY Oneonta Planetarium, and we will** build our own universes and write our own legends. On the last day of the workshop, we will present an exhibit and program for parents and friends.

**4. BRIGHT KIDS BOOK CLUB - Grades 3 - 8 (Ages 8 - 14) - Schedule to be announced.** Call 607-829-5055 for details or email [info@brighthillpress.org](mailto:info@brighthillpress.org). Participants vote on books to read and discuss; each student gets a free copy of the book. This is a **FREE PROGRAM** of Bright Hill Press & Literary Center, but students must sign up in advance and must come to at least 2 of the 3 sessions for each book.
