MORE ABOUT BRIGHT HILL'S LITERARY WORKSHOPS PROGRAM.

Note: The cost of the workshops is \$250 (\$170 for regional students), and full and partial scholarships, made possible by the Delaware Youth Bureau through the NYS Office of Child and Family Services and the NYSCouncil on the Arts Edu. program, supported by Gov. All Delaware Academy students receive full scholarships, made possible by the Abraham Kellogg Educational Fund. Sometimes, if possible, we make spring or summer trips to museums or other locations. Decisions about trips will be made in late April.

JUNIOR INTERNSHIP TRAINEE PROGRAM

BHLC continues its workshop internships program in 2024. It includes the BHLC Workshop Junior Internship Trainee Program, and it will be led by Bertha Rogers. To be eligible for the program, students must be in 7th grade or higher and must have completed at least (3) Bright Hill Literary Workshops for Kids programs. Trainees must participate in at least 2 of the 3 literary workshops offered during 2024; there is no payment for the first year, but during the second year, trainees will receive a \$50 stipend for each 5-day workshop; after the third year, trainees will receive a \$75 stipend for each 5-day workshop.

During the first year, trainees will be assigned one younger student, and during the second year, one or two younger students. By the third year, trainees will receive a \$75 stipend for each 5-day workshop and will work with various students. Each trainee will work with and report to Bertha Rogers, leader of the BHLC Literary Workshops for Kids Program. High-school students who are full-time residents of Delaware County are eligible for full and part-time summer internships that will also include working in the administrative offices.
