TRAINEE program To be eligible, students must be in 7th grade or higher and have completed at least (3) BH Literary Workshops. Trainees must participate in 2 of the 5 2025 workshops; there is no payment for year 1; year 2, trainees receive a \$50 stipend for each 5-day workshop; year 3, trainees receive a \$75 stipend for each 5-day workshop.

- 1. Winter February 17- 21 Penguins, Portals, and Puppets. We'll explore the world of penguins in drawings and paintings, make portal sculptures, create a puppet show; and we'll write poems, stories, and scripts about them.
- 2. Spring April 21 25 Foxes, Folktales, and Fancy Masks. Our woodland friends appear in many stories. We'll learn about foxes and their habitat to make dioramas. We'll read and write stories, poems, riddles, and make masks for our folktales.
- 3. SUMMER June 25 July 2 Sun, Moon & Stars. Imaginary Creatures and their friends. We'll work in clay, drawing, speaking, singing as well as in movement and Costumes. Note: this workshop includes half days June 25 & 26 when DA children will take the bus to Bright Hill. Fri June 27, Mon. June 30, Tues. July 1, Wed. July 2 are 9am-2:30pm as usual.
- **4. Summer July 28 August 1- Trees, Rocks, & Water.** An exploration of Keepsake stories: objects you hold close. Storytelling, Writing and Presentation.
- **5. Summer August 18 August 22 Sense and Nonsense.** We all love the wacky worlds of nonsense poetry. We will read, write, recite, and practice acting skills. Characters, Costumes, drawings. We'll also work with limericks and Haiku.
